Eastern Illinois Foodbank Receives \$87,000 Grant from Local Jewel-Osco Foundation Nourishing Neighbors to Help Feed School Children During Summer

URBANA, II — 08/12/2021 — Eastern Illinois Foodbank continues to help provide food assistance to those facing food insecurity and is honored that Jewel-Osco Foundation Nourishing Neighbors is helping. Eastern Illinois Foodbank announced today that it received an \$87,000 grant from the Nourishing Neighbors Summer Meals program to help feed children during the summer. The program is part of Jewel-Osco's Nourishing Neighbors Community Relief Initiative.

Funds from the grant will be used to bring 17 foodmobiles to McLean County targeting families with schoolaged children. Foodmobiles are a system of mobile food pantries designed to increase access to nutritionally-dense food for residents in rural and under-served communities. Each foodmobile delivers approximately 10,000 pounds of food to 160 households facing with hunger.

"With school out for the summer, many children in our community don't have adequate access to proper nutrition. While Eastern Illinois Foodbank works hard to meet the needs of these children, we need help to accomplish this mission," said Kelly Daly, President and CEO of Eastern Illinois Foodbank. "We're grateful that Jewel-Osco Foundation Nourishing Neighbors are partnering with us to keep kids fed this summer."

Jewel-Osco Nourishing Neighbors summer meals grants help organizations that work to bridge the nutrition gap for students without access to school meal programs during the summer break.
